Constitutional text

- Historical argument
- Structural argument



TIERS OF SCRUTINY

1. Strict scrutiny:

- ✓ **compelling** governmental interest &
- ✓ **narrowly** tailored to that interest

2. Intermediate scrutiny:


- ✓ **important** governmental interest &
- ✓ **substantial** relation to that interest (not least restrictive means)

3. Rational basis:

- ✓ law achieves some **legitimate** interest
- ✓ Means are **rational** or **reasonably** related

WHAT IS UNPROTECTED SPEECH?

WHAT IS PROTECTED SPEECH?

- Some types of speech are unprotected or less protected by the First Amendment
 - If unprotected → can be prohibited and punished
 - Must fit within established exception:
 - e.g., Obscenity
 - If less protected → government has increased latitude in regulation them
 - Does not meet criteria for exceptions but...still?
 - e.g., sexually explicit expression that is not obscene





MOVIE DAY AT SCOTUS

MILLER V. CALIFORNIA (1973)

Set out a three part test (Miller Test) as a guideline for determining whether speech or expression is obscene:

- 1. Would the average person applying contemporary community standards find that the material, taken as a whole, appeals to prurient interest (an immoderate, unwholesome, or unusual interest in sex)?
- 2. Does the work depict or describe, in a patently offensive way, sexual conduct specifically outlawed by applicable state law?
- 3. Does the work, taken as a whole, lack serious literary, artistic, political, or scientific value?

ASHCROFT V. FREE SPEECH (2002)

The Child Pornography Prevention Act of 1996 prohibits:

"any visual depiction, including any photograph, film, video, picture, or computer or computer-generated image or picture" that "is, or *appears* to be, of a minor engaging in sexually explicit conduct," and any sexually explicit image that is "advertised, promoted, presented, described, or distributed in such a manner that conveys the impression" it depicts "a minor engaging in sexually explicit conduct."

ASHCROFT V. FREE SPEECH (2002)

Does the Child Pornography Prevention Act of 1996 abridge freedom of speech?


Yes: inconsistent with both Miller and Ferber
